WATER/WASTEWATER FACILITIES OPERATOR

The Water/Wastewater Facilities Operators are key positions within the Village of Fort Simpson. This position will have primary day-to-day responsibility for maintaining the Water Treatment Plant, Distribution System, Wastewater Treatment Plant and Wastewater Collection System of the municipality. The Water/Wastewater Facilities Operator is responsible for production and delivery of potable water, the efficient collection and treatment of wastewater, providing adequate services to the community in these respects.

The Successful applicant will possess (but not limited to) the following qualifications:

- Valid Class 5 driver's license.
- A Minimum of grade 12
- Possess a Provincial or Territorial Certification in Water Treatment, Water Distribution, Wastewater Treatment or Wastewater Collection Systems Operations. Equivalencies may be considered.
- 3-5 years of municipal/industrial experience with one of the above certifications.
- Must be able to endure physical activity.
- Excellent verbal, analytical, organizational and written skills.
- Must be able to work in outdoor conditions (summer/winter).
- Must possess good mechanical skills.
- Must be able to work independently.
- Must possess good computer skills.
