



## **Village of Fort Simpson Emergency Preparedness Information**

Due to below average water levels on both the Mackenzie and Liard Rivers, the risk of spring flooding within the Village of Fort Simpson has been determined to be LOW.

As we move into the summer wildfire season, the Local Emergency Management Organization stresses the importance of preparation by recommending the following:

- ❖ Keep vehicle fuel levels topped up
- ❖ Keep food, water, extra clothing, blankets, sleeping bags, tents, important documents, medications, and any other items you will require packed and ready to go
- ❖ Get your property ready by following the FireSmart recommendations at:
