



Attention Residents: Fire and Road Closure Updates

September 12, 2025

Residents are advised that while fire **FS14** has been limited in activity on the Highway 1 (Western) side, it has been active on the Southern flanks, resulting in increased smoke. ECC helicopter crews are bucketing these sections aggressively at this time.

While it is not expected to close, Highway 1 is being monitored for fire and smoke activity. Please remain cautious when driving through smoke and use hazard lights.

Rain is currently forecasted for Sunday, which if it comes to pass should take a lot of the remaining energy from the fire. High overnight humidity is also helping to reduce fire spread as of late.

The community and airport of **Fort Simpson is still not under direct threat.**
